Italian Hospitality School announces the call-3 for the participation in the competition in the Erasmus Adult Education Project KA1 2024 “Adult Education Mobility” with project No. 2024-1-IT02-KA121-ADU-000201383 for Individual learning mobility of adult learners during the period from May 1, 2026, by May 31, 2026.

### 1. Enhance Digital Competence of Adult Learners and Educators (B-level training in Spain)

The project aims to strengthen both basic and advanced digital competences of low-skilled adult learners and educators of the Italian Hospitality School. During the mobility at **Centro Público de Formación de Personas Adultas Miguel Hernández (Spain)**, participants will follow **B-level digital skills training**, enabling them to use modern technologies more confidently in hospitality and daily life.

Digital competence development goes beyond technical skills: it requires adapting to new social practices and overcoming mismatches between adults’ previous life experiences and today’s digital environment. Training activities will therefore be designed to connect new technologies with the everyday realities of low-skilled adults, increasing intrinsic motivation and supporting social inclusion. Digital technologies also promote participation in community life and strengthen adults’ ability to engage in modern communication.

### 2. Support Foreign Language Development (Basic Spanish and French + English for educators)

The project promotes foreign language learning as a tool for social participation, cultural exposure, and personal empowerment. During the mobility in Spain, low-skilled adult learners will attend **basic Spanish and French language courses**, enabling them to communicate in simple everyday situations and gain confidence in multilingual environments.

Learning languages in a social setting fosters cooperation, shared goals, and intercultural understanding. Educators of the Italian Hospitality School will improve their teaching and presentation skills in English and learn how to adapt methodologies, materials, and learning environments to the needs of low-skilled adults, including age-related barriers such as slower reaction times, health issues, and motivational challenges. A shared linguistic base will facilitate mutual learning and more effective communication with local community representatives.

### **3. Improve Employment Opportunities, EU Awareness, and Sustainable Development Competences**

Mobility activities will provide low-skilled adult learners with high-quality training tailored to their educational level, combined with the valuable experience of travelling to another EU country. This will strengthen their understanding of Europe as a community with shared political, economic, and social principles.

Participants will also develop competences related to **Sustainable Development in hospitality**, which are essential for lifelong learning and competitiveness in the labour market. Educators will enhance their knowledge of Sustainable Development issues, improve intercultural competences, and learn practical methodologies related to SDG-aligned teaching (SDGC). These skills will support the continuous improvement of sustainability practices within the Italian Hospitality School and the broader hospitality sector.

Number of competition mobilities: The competition includes 6 individual learning mobilities of adult learners, up to 10 days each mobility. At least 4 of 6 participants selected will be participate with fewer opportunities.

Mobility Schedule: Individual schedule for up to 10 days mobility of each participant will be arranged in May. The 2 (two) travel days will be included in the overall schedule.

The participant will develop skills and competences in:

- Digital skills
- English/Spanish/French Language
- Communication
- Intercultural Understanding

The participants are offered and the following will be covered:

- The organization provides the participant with accommodation and insurance, as well as pays up to following amount for 8 days - EUR 415.66 (four hundred fifteen euros, sixty-six cents), in case of up to 10 days mobility, thus providing the participant with the necessary support for air tickets and local transportation expenses as well as catering. The organisation shall ensure that the services provided meet the required quality and safety standards.

The board of the 3 persons will review the applications during the period from April 23, 2026, by April 26, 2026, and will announce the results till the April 27, 2026, depending on the evaluation date.
